

"Arduino has this magical combination of being simple enough that you don't have to be an electrical engineer to do it, but complicated enough where you can do very interesting things with it," says Michael Shiloh who along with partner Judy Castro used Arduino to create these movable art pieces.

is proprietary, the design of the physical board is not, nor is the software. Therefore, dozens if not hundreds of smaller companies make Arduino-like boards for sale that do different functions. Many programs created by artists are available for free online.

The most basic Arduino programming takes as little as five minutes. An Arduino-made board comes equipped with a blinking light right out of the box. Plug the board into your computer through a USB cable, and the software offers several simple, text-based lines of programming to play around with. On two lines are numbers; one tells how long the light stays on and one tells how long the light stays off. Monkey around with those numbers and you can make the light on the board flash faster or slower within a couple of key strokes.

"Arduino has lowered the barrier," says Andrew Sliwinski, an interaction designer who will teach an Arduino 101 course Oct. 16 at the East Bay Mini Maker Faire. "It's not that the Arduino does anything you couldn't do before the Arduino. The real special thing about the Arduino is that it makes developing these projects easier."

For example, in the 1980s, programmer Sliwinski had to learn BASIC, a computer language, before he could make anything flash on his screen. Now, with Arduino, a person new to the field can see results quickly.

last month with news stories about Brooklyn-based New York University student Matt Richardson, who used Arduino to hack his remote control to mute his television for 30 seconds every time "Jersey Shore" breakout star Snooki's name was

mentioned.

The code to do this project, Richardson says, was "really easy." In fact, it was a mashup between two projects he found using Arduino code. One decoded Closed Captioning, and the second showed how to make a universal remote. "I took what two people did and mashed them," he says. And that's one key to Arduino's success. Because it's open source, projects can build off one another without threats of copyright suits.

Artist and toy-maker Christopher Schardt used Arduino in his "Garden of Rockets" fire sculptures shown during the Labor Day Burning Man event. You can see how they work Sunday at the Burning Man Decompression Fair in San Francisco.

In his case, Schardt programmed Arduino to aim his sculptures' fire burners, which provide the thrust for the moving parts. When the piece is on, the fire creates patterns such as figure eights and flowers.

"I would not have had the time this year or last year to make 'Garden of Rockets' (using older methods), and therefore, Arduino was a tremendous boon," he says.

And while adults might have great uses for interactive art projects, kids — who are like flies to honey when it comes to robotics — also can see quick results using Arduino, Make Magazine's Woods says.

"Here a kid can say, 'I just programmed a board that automatically sent a tweet out.' That's when the brush fire starts. That's what Arduino is all about. It allows us to light the brush fire of creativity."
